RE: Reporting Hours to the Southern California Pipe Trades
Health & Welfare Fund

According to our records, you are signed either to the Master Labor Agreement between U.A. District Council #16 and the CPMCA or to an Independent Agreement with similar terms to the CPMCA MLA.

Please find enclosed a recent resolution of the Joint Arbitration Board which modifies your collective bargaining agreement. **This charge requires signatory employers to contribute to the Southern California Pipe Trades Health & Welfare Fund, on behalf of participating Owners & Corporate Officers, based on 120 hours per month**, beginning with hours worked in January 2009 (reportable by February 10, 2009).

Your agreement's other provisions related to fringe benefit payments for Owners and Officers remain unchanged; in that **you must continue to report 110 hours, or hours worked, whichever is greater, for all funds other than Health & Welfare.**

This change will require you to submit two separate Employer Contribution Report forms each month; one for 120 hours for Health & Welfare, and a second report for the remainder of the funds to which you contribute. You will be sent revised EXCEL sheets that reflect this change via e-mail if we have a current e-mail address. New Employer reports will also be mailed to your office. If you pay for fewer than 120 per month for Health & Welfare, then we are required to send you shortage notices, on which we must collect. Thank you for your cooperation.
